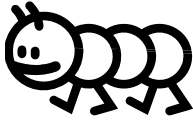

LAST DAYS OF SCHOOL

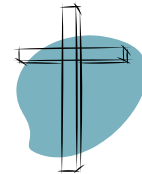
TUESDAY May 15th –Walk to Lawson Park—Weather Permitting. Parents are not required to come, but we could use some volunteers. Just let us know.
